RE: 2020 Approvals under the Heritage Delegation By-law

PURPOSE OF THE MEMORANDUM:

To update Council on approvals given by the Commissioner of Planning & Development through delegated authority as approved by Council through the Heritage Delegation By-law.

BACKGROUND:

On May 25, 2020, Council adopted By-law No.2020-0030, the Heritage Delegation By-law. With this By-law, Council delegates power under the *Ontario Heritage Act* for certain types of alterations to properties designated under Part IV and Part IV of the *Ontario Heritage Act* to the Commissioner of Planning & Development.

COMMENTS:

Per Part V, Section 7 of the Heritage Delegation By-law, staff are to provide a list of approvals under the Heritage Delegation By-law on a semi-annual basis. Appendix A attached to this memorandum lists the projects that were approved in 2020 following the adoption of the By-law in May 2020.
