### **PURPOSE OF THE MEMORANDUM:**

To update Council on approvals given by the Commissioner of Planning & Development through delegated authority as approved by Council through the Heritage Delegation By-law.

### **BACKGROUND:**

On May 25, 2020, Council adopted By-law No.2020-0030, the Heritage Delegation By-law. With this By-law, Council delegates power under the *Ontario Heritage Act* for certain types of alterations to properties designated under Part IV and Part IV of the *Ontario Heritage Act* to the Commissioner of Planning & Development.


**CONCLUSION:**
