



BY-LAW NO. 2021-0053

A By-law to provide for the use of Online (Internet) Voting for the Advanced Voting period and Optical Scanning Vote Tabulators for the purpose of counting votes at the 2022 Municipal Election.

WHEREAS, Section 42 of the Municipal Elections Act, S.O. 1996, as amended, provides that the Council of a municipality may pass a by-law to authorize the use of optical scanning vote tabulators for the purpose of counting votes at a municipal election;

AND WHEREAS, Section 42 of the Municipal Elections Act, S.O. 1996, as amended, also provides that the Council of a municipality may pass a by-law to authorize electors to use an alternative voting method that does not require electors to attend at a voting place in order to vote;

AND WHEREAS on October 25th, 2021, Council for the Town of Halton Hills adopted Report No. ADMIN-2021-0021 dated September 7, 2021, in which certain recommendations were made relating to the 2022 Municipal Election – Alternate Voting Methods;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Halton Hills considers it desirable to pass such a by-law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF HALTON HILLS ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT optical scanning vote tabulators are hereby authorized to be used for the 2022 Municipal Election for the Town of Halton Hills in accordance with Section 42 of the Municipal Elections Act, S.O. 1996, as amended.
2. THAT Online (Internet) Voting is hereby authorized to be used for the advanced voting period of the 2022 Municipal Election for the Town of Halton Hills in accordance with Section 42 of the Municipal Elections Act, S.O. 1996, as amended.
3. THAT By-law No. 2017-0020 is hereby repealed.
