Community Benefits Charges Strategy and Parkland Dedication By-law Update

Minutes of the Public Meeting held on Monday, May 2, 2022 at 7:01 p.m., in the Council Chambers, Town of Halton Hills and Via Zoom.

Councillor J. Hurst chaired the meeting.

Councillor J. Hurst advised the following:

This is a public consultation meeting being held for the 2022 Community Benefits Charges Strategy and the proposed Parkland Dedication by-law under sections 37 and 42 of the Planning Act, 1990, respectively, as amended. The purpose of the meeting is to give the public an opportunity to ask questions, provide comments, and make representations on the Town's Community Benefits Charges Strategy and proposed by-law, as well as on the proposed Parkland Dedication by-law. Council will not be taking any action this evening on these studies or by-laws.

Prior to receiving public comments, the Town's consultant, Andrew Grunda from Watson & Associates Economists Ltd., will provide a brief presentation of the findings of the studies.
