



BY-LAW NO. 2022-0050

A By-law to amend By-law No.1984-0001, being a by-law to regulate traffic and parking on highways under the jurisdiction of the Town of Halton Hills.

WHEREAS Subsection 11(3) of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, Chap.25 authorizes Councils to pass by-laws for regulating traffic and parking on highways;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to the said authority Council for the Corporation of the Town of Halton Hills has enacted By-law No. 1984-0001, as amended, to regulate traffic and parking on highways under the jurisdiction of the Town of Halton Hills;

AND WHEREAS Council now deems it expedient and necessary to amend the provisions of By-law No.1984-0001;

AND WHEREAS on July 4, 2022, Council for the Town of Halton Hills approved Report No. TPW-2022-0022, dated June 14, 2022, in which certain recommendations were made relating to Automated Speed Enforcement – Community Safety Zones.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF HALTON HILLS ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Schedule “29” (Community Safety Zones – Signs on Display) of By-law No. 84-1 be amended by the addition of the following:
 - 1) Churchill Road North, the addition of a Community Safety Zone from Tanners Drive (North) to Peel Street.
 - 2) Maple Avenue, the addition of a Community Safety Zone from Mountainview Road North to Guelph Street (Highway 7).
 - 3) Miller Drive, the addition of a Community Safety Zone from Eighth Line to Argyll Road.
 - 4) Barber Drive (East), the addition of a Community Safety Zone from Argyll Road to Niagara Trail.
 - 5) Danby Road, the addition of a Community Safety Zone from Barber Drive to Silver Pond Drive.
 - 6) Eaton Street, the addition of a Community Safety Zone from Forsyth Crescent to Chaplin Crescent.
 - 7) 15 Side Road, the addition of a Community Safety Zone from Trafalgar Road to Belmont Boulevard (west intersection).
 - 8) 22 Side Road, the addition of a Community Safety Zone from Fifth Line (east intersection) to Elizabeth Street.
