## RECOMMENDATION:

THAT Report No. ADMIN-2022-0040 dated August 19, 2022 regarding a request from Property Owner of 220 Elmore Drive for a variance to the Fence By-law 2002-0060, as amended is received;

AND FURTHER THAT the fence variance contained in Report No. ADMIN-2022-0040
a) be granted to Property Owner, 220 Elmore Drive, as requested;

OR
b) be granted to Property Owner, 220 Elmore Drive, with conditions as set out in the decision of Council;

OR
c) not be granted to Property Owner, 220 Elmore Drive

## KEY POINTS:

The following are key points for consideration with respect to this report:

- The Fence By-law defines a Fence to include a railing, wall, line of posts, wire, gate, boards, pickets, privacy screens or other similar substances, used to enclose or divide in whole or in part a yard or other land or to provide privacy.
- The Fence By-law defines a Privacy Screen as a visual barrier used to shield any part of a Yard from view from any adjacent Lot or Highway.
- The applicant is requesting a variance for the rear yard, interior side yard and front yard to retain a wood fence measuring 2.4 meters ( 8 feet) in height.
- The application for the variance was received by staff after the fence had been installed.
- The Applicant is requesting an increased height for privacy purposes.


## BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION:

The municipality has enacted legislation that controls the height of fences within the municipality, under the authority of the Municipal Act, 2001. The property owner of 220 Elmore Drive is seeking relief from the by-law which restricts the height of a fence in the front, side, and rear yards. The height of a fence in rear or side yard cannot exceed 2.14 metres ( 7 feet) in height. The height of a fence in the front yard cannot exceed 0.9 meters (3 feet) in height for closed construction and 1.71 metres ( 5 feet 6 inches) for open construction.

An inspection of the property was performed on August 17, 2022, which identified the fence has already been erected and measures 2.4 metres ( 8 feet) in height. The request for the variance was prompted by an enforcement complaint requesting staff to investigate the newly erected fence for compliance with the Town's Fence By-law 20020060.

The variance is described in the following table:
