Dear Mr. Linhardt:

RE: Town of Halton Hills Water Servicing – Georgetown and Acton Groundwater Supply

In response to the email received on July 18, 2022 regarding the request for additional groundwater-based servicing allocation in both Acton and Georgetown Urban Areas, this letter confirms allocation approvals and outlines Town/Region commitments.

The Town of Halton Hills has requested:

- The release of all remaining available capacity units in the Georgetown groundwater system, or 300 capacity units.
- The release of 300 capacity units in the Acton groundwater system.

Based on the monitoring data that is available and an assessment of the system response that has occurred, the Region approves this request.

As previously communicated, the quantity of permitted groundwater based supply in Georgetown is finite until the transfer of South Georgetown to lake-based service is complete. This release of 300 capacity units in Georgetown represents all of the remaining capacity in the Georgetown water system prior to the lake-based transfer. The Acton system does not currently have the same constraints. Additional allocation requests for Acton can be reviewed in the future as required, subject to system monitoring results.

We request that the Town continues to notify staff when capacity is assigned (in both Georgetown and Acton) so that staff can monitor system response as new development is connected.

We trust that the above addresses the request and provides sufficient capacity for short-term development needs. Please feel free to contact me if you have any questions or concerns.
