SUBJECT: Stormwater Master Plan – Intent to Form Advisory Committees

PURPOSE OF THE MEMORANDUM:

To inform the Mayor and Members of Council of Staff's intent to establish advisory committees for input to the Town of Halton Hills Stormwater Master Plan.

BACKGROUND:

The Town of Halton Hills has initiated a study to complete a Stormwater Master Plan to ensure stormwater is properly managed throughout the planning horizon. The Town has retained AECOM Canada Ltd. to assist in undertaking the Master Plan, as noted in Report No. TPW-2021-0022 and recommended by Council.

The Master Plan will help the Town understand how the existing stormwater management network is functioning, identify opportunities and vulnerabilities, and inform short- and long-term planning to improve its stormwater infrastructure. The study results will assist in addressing issues before stormwater assets fail or are otherwise unable to fulfill their intended purpose.

COMMENTS:

To solicit feedback from key departments within the Town as well as external agencies, it is Staff's intent to establish two (2) advisory committees for the Stormwater Master Plan: a Steering Committee, and a Technical Advisory Committee.

The Steering Committee shall include representatives from various Town departments and will be involved in setting appropriate levels of service expected by the community, developing program goals, and establishing funding targets.
