TOWN OF HALTON HILLS

BY-LAW NO. 2023-0035

A By-law to amend By-law No.1984-0001, being a by-law to regulate traffic and parking on highways under the jurisdiction of the Town of Halton Hills.

WHEREAS Subsection 11(3) of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, Chap.25 authorizes Councils to pass by-laws for regulating traffic and parking on highways;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to the said authority Council for the Corporation of the Town of Halton Hills has enacted By-law No. 1984-0001, as amended, to regulate traffic and parking on highways under the jurisdiction of the Town of Halton Hills;

AND WHEREAS Council now deems it expedient and necessary to amend the provisions of By-law No. 1984-0001;

AND WHEREAS on May 8, 2023, Council for the Town of Halton Hills approved Report No. TPW-2023-006, dated April 13, 2023, in which certain recommendations were made relating to the Uniform Traffic Control By-law 84-01.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF HALTON HILLS ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That Schedule "26" (No Heavy Traffic Signs on Display) of By-law No. 84-1 be amended by the addition of the following:
 - 1. 22 Side Road, the addition of Heavy Traffic Prohibited zone between Fourth Line and Fifth Line (West).
 - 2. Fifth Line, the addition of Heavy Traffic Prohibited zone between 17 Side Road and 22 Side Road.
 - 3. Fifth Line, the addition on Heavy Traffic Prohibited zone between a point 2734 m south of Highway 7 and Highway 7.
