

BY-LAW NO. 2023-0059

A By-law to permanently close the section of Tenth Line shown as Part 4, 20R-22425

WHEREAS Sections 27(1) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, provides that a municipality may pass a by-law in respect to a highway to which it has jurisdiction;

AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the Town of Halton Hills is the owner and has jurisdiction over the section of Tenth Line south of Steeles Avenue;

AND WHEREAS the section of the road shown as Part 4, 20R-22425 is surplus to the Town's needs; and the Town now wishes to permanently close this section and dispose of it to the adjacent landowner;

AND WHEREAS the Corporation of the Town of Halton Hills has fulfilled the requirements of its Notice By-law No. 2008-0001;

AND WHEREAS on May 29, 2023, Council for the Town of Halton Hills approved Report No. TPW-2023-008 dated April 17, 2023, in which certain recommendations were made relating to the closure and disposition of a section of the road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF HALTON HILLS ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT the section of the existing road allowance known as Tenth Line shown as Part 4, 20R-22425 and further described in Schedule "A" attached hereto, be and the same is hereby declared surplus to the Town's needs.
- 2. THAT the section of the existing road allowance known as Tenth Line shown as Part 4, 20R-22425 and further described in Schedule "A" attached hereto, be and the same is hereby permanently closed.
