



**BY-LAW NO. 2023-0084**

A By-law to amend By-law No.1984-0001, being a by-law to regulate traffic and parking on highways under the jurisdiction of the Town of Halton Hills.

**WHEREAS** Subsection 11(3) of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, Chap.25 authorizes Councils to pass by-laws for regulating traffic and parking on highways;

**AND WHEREAS** pursuant to the said authority Council for the Corporation of the Town of Halton Hills has enacted By-law No. 1984-0001, as amended, to regulate traffic and parking on highways under the jurisdiction of the Town of Halton Hills;

**AND WHEREAS** Council now deems it expedient and necessary to amend the provisions of By-law No. 1984-0001;

**AND WHEREAS** on September 18, 2023, Council for the Town of Halton Hills approved Report No. TPW-2023-020, dated August 10, 2023, in which certain recommendations were made relating to the Uniform Traffic Control By-law 84-01.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF HALTON HILLS ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That Schedule "29" (Community Safety Zones – Signs on Display) of By-law No. 84-1 be amended by the addition of the following:
  - 1) Acton Boulevard, the addition of a Community Safety Zone from Peel Street to Norman Avenue (East).
  - 2) Queen Street (Highway 7), the addition of a Community Safety Zone from Eastern Avenue to Churchill Road.
  - 3) Princess Anne Drive, the addition of a Community Safety Zone from Grey Owl Run to Charles Street.
  - 4) Charles Street, the addition of a Community Safety Zone from Princess Anne Drive to Maple Avenue.
  - 5) Weber Drive, the addition of a Community Safety Zone from Delrex Boulevard to Sims Gate.
  - 6) Rexway Drive, the addition of a Community Safety Zone from Delrex Boulevard to Shelley Street.
  - 7) Sinclair Avenue, the addition of a Community Safety Zone from Mountainview Road South to Duncan Drive.
  - 8) Argyll Road, the addition of a Community Safety Zone from Eighth Line to Barber Drive (West).

- 9) Barber Drive, the addition of a Community Safety Zone from Argyll Road to Danby Road (West).
- 10) Main Street (Glen Williams), the addition of a Community Safety Zone from Confederation Street to Prince Street.
- 11) Main Street (Glen Williams), the addition of a Community Safety Zone from Prince Street to Mountain Street.
