


What features are you most looking forward to in the Preferred Park Concept (pick 3).


Question options


Multi-purpose courts are proposed in various locations. What type of uses would you like on the multi-purpose courts? (Check all that apply)














Q12 The park offers a variety of spaces for public art to be incorporated. Where should public art be included? (Check all that apply)










