

Introduction

- First introduced in Canada in 2013 by Toronto Public Library and the Martin Prosperity Institute
- HHPL developed a template for public libraries
- HHPL's template is now a standard tool used by libraries across Ontario
- Identified the market value of programs, services and collections




Circulation of Library Materials


