





Potential customers in Halton Hills, who are actually closer to us than those who live in Milton, may be information posted and once they see our address immediately lose interest because they assume we are too far away. Although they could look on a map to see exactly where we are, most people don't. As a Georgetown resident if you see that a business is located in Milton, you're assuming that it will take you at

least 20 minutes to get to that location if not more due to the high volume of population in traffic in that city. Our roots are in Halton Hills. We belong to the Halton Hills Chamber of Commerce. I grew up in Halton Hills and attended schools in Halton Hills. My network is in Halton Hills. I would like to be able to appeal to that group of people more. I've also felt the effect when trying to apply for local awards or post in local Facebook groups. One year in particular are nominations were completely eliminated from the local paper because someone on staff of the independent saw our address and removed us from contention when I post and local Facebook groups and have to post my full address at will often delete my post or kick me out of the group when the rules are That you must be a local to participate. As a resident, it has caused problems when people enter our address into things such as Google or Apple Maps as well. If somebody knows that we belong to Halton Hills, but sees the address pop up as Milton they often select the wrong one and get lost or vice versa when they see the address is in Milton but the map is taking them north they often get confused and get lost.

Changing my postal code would create tremendous costs to me in time, dollars and loss of long term connection with important clients and service providers. Perhaps the Provincial Government should be picking up the cost of any change SINCE THEY CREATED REGIONAL GOVERNMENT without consulting the many communities affected. Delegating repeatedly over 40 years to the local Milton Post Office for an upgraded address to solve delivery problems, identity verification problems etc. was a failed exercise. Delegating to my MPPs for help has resulted in no change over the years. Nor has delegating to my local MPs. So I am very pleased that the Town is going to attempt some positive change. My long term considered advice to the Town's negotiating team would be this: instead of changing my postal code we should ask the Federal Government to direct the Post Office to modify our Town Name from Milton to Halton Hills on the CP computers because most businesses and government services reference the Canada Post data base to confirm my identity. This approach would leave my Postal Code alone so that the delivery system remains unchanged from the Milton Post Office. This choice could save CP the cost and problems associated with reassigning sorting and delivery of our rural mail and the consequent impact on their staff and vehicles and sorting capability - they currently serve over 300 Halton Hills households along the RR3 Milton and RR5 Milton mail routes. If Canada Post agrees to do this, rural residents will have a reliable address for their affairs and CP will not have to restructure their current sorting and delivery network.. At the same time they will have created a template for the dozens of other rural Ontario communities that have the same problem. For example every time there is a Provincial or Federal election I get riding information from Milton but not for Halton Hills Wellington - my riding. And my friend on 4th Line rural Milton (Nassagaweya) gets election mail not from Milton his riding but from my riding (Wellington Halton Hills) because his mail comes through Rockwood which is a town in my riding. Contacting riding associations has not solved the problem because they destroy their mailing lists after elections. Consequently thousands of voters across the greater GTA are effectively disenfranchised if they rely on mail from their riding organizations. So once again please work with Canada Post to make just one change on their computers for rural route mail delivery and that is to match the mailing address TOWN NAME to the town in which the resident lives. There will be a cost to Canada Post to make this change but they are a Crown Corporation created to serve Canadians and this one time long overdue change will not put much of a dent in the millions of dollars of profit they post every year. Hopefully all the other communities in Ontario affected by this problem will lend their support.
