


What is the Mobility Master Plan?

“Mobility” – The ability to move or be moved freely and conveniently.

- Ensuring that traveling around Town is simple
- Establish a long-range vision
- Enhance mobility and travelling needs
- Build a safe and inclusive transportation system for all
- Advance and prioritize a multi-modal transportation equity

Project Purpose

- Address key transportation issues, meet current future community needs and propose recommendations for the Town to manage future growth
- Ensure conformity with provincial and regional policies and guide future growth in the Town to the year 2051
- Ensure compliance with other legislation and regulations that have implications for Official Plan policies

Key Study Principles

The Mobility Master Plan will plan for the 2051 horizon and beyond.

Connectivity – An integrated network, a focus on moving people efficiently through all modes of transportation

Safety – A network that prioritizes safety for all users within the Right-of-Way

Sustainability – To promote healthy lifestyles and environmental sustainability, and encourage active transportation modes


Affordability – Promoting economic growth through an efficient transportation network
