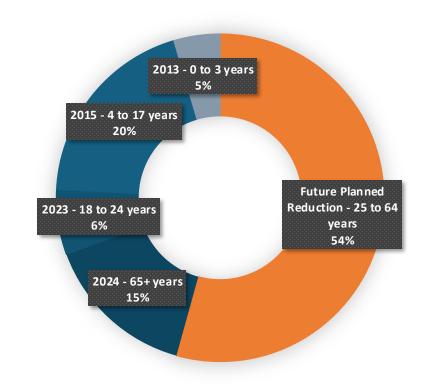


2024 Budget – Operating Highlights

Halton Hills Population Fine Free by Age



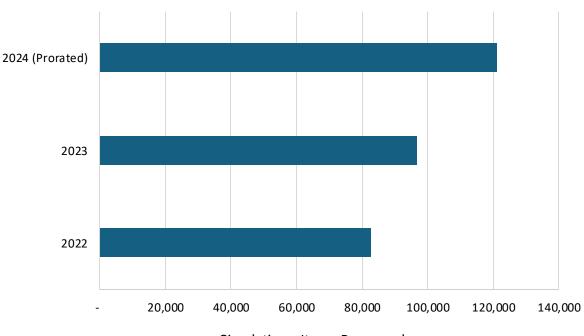

- Providing equitable access through phased elimination of fines



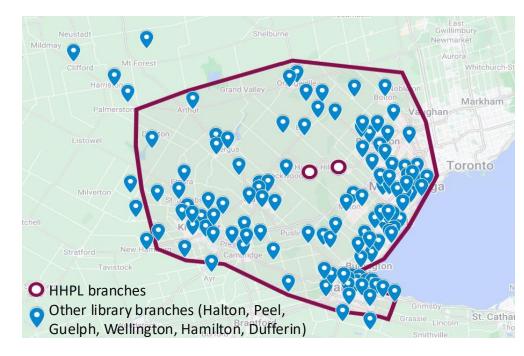


2025 Deferred Operating

- Replaces end-of-life IT hardware
- Projects for 2024 include:
 - Video conversion tools

 - RFID circulation/security hardware
 - Early literacy stations
 - Public internet computers

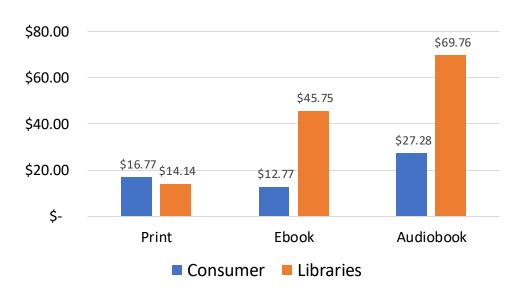




Library Materials:

Average Prices Libraries Pay for Materials (\$US)

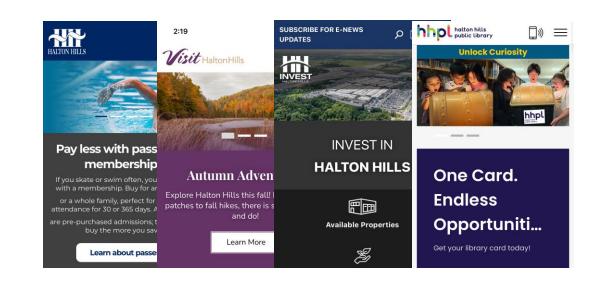

Unified Website Development Project – Library:

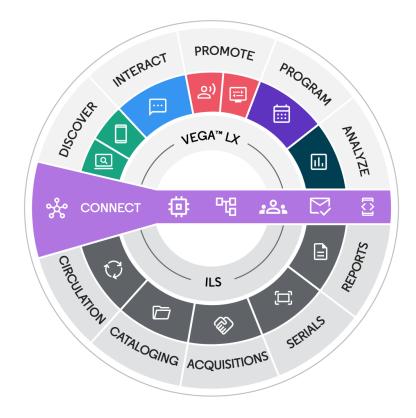
- One-time request to implement Library's portion of unified website strategy

- Current system is being phased out by vendor

 - Added program registration, promotion tools and online library membership registration
