We are committed to ensuring all music selections are free of profanity, explicit content, or inappropriate lyrics.

To maintain these standards, our dedicated committee will oversee all music selections, ensuring they align with our organization's values and community expectations.

Walk-up music has become a common feature in sports, adding excitement and fostering player confidence. By granting this request, you would be supporting our efforts to create a memorable and enjoyable experience for all involved.

Each game typically features about 60 at-bats (combined for both teams), amounting to approximately six minutes of music in total. We are confident this modest use of amplified music will enhance the game-day experience without disrupting the surrounding community.
