Energy Coach (up to 4 hours one-on-one)

- Identify best opportunities based on resident priorities (save money, save energy, reduce emissions, increase home comfort, etc)
- Identify low- and no-cost actions

- Approximate cost
- Guidance for DIY options
- Determine rebate eligibility and application process
- Help understand financing options available
- Help estimate return on investment

- Help understand and compare quotes
- Available to answer any resident questions if needed

- Assist with updating information in virtual tool to estimate energy saving impacts

- Available to support resident if needed

Town Staff to engage resident on their experience and measure impact of program

Customizable online Energy Savings Opportunities Tool (unlimited use)

- Quantify potential savings for retrofits
