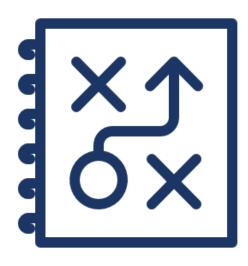

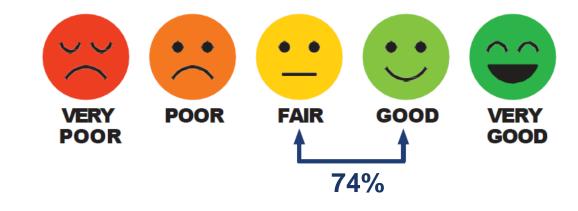


State of the Infrastructure - Valuation and Condition

- Transportation and Transit \$1,207 million
- Environmental Services \$549 million
- Recreation and Culture \$135 million
- Parks and Open Space \$65 million
- Fire Services \$39 million
- Library Services \$36 million
- Administrative Services \$28 million

Town Portfolio = \$2.06 Billion

Overall Condition of the assets:





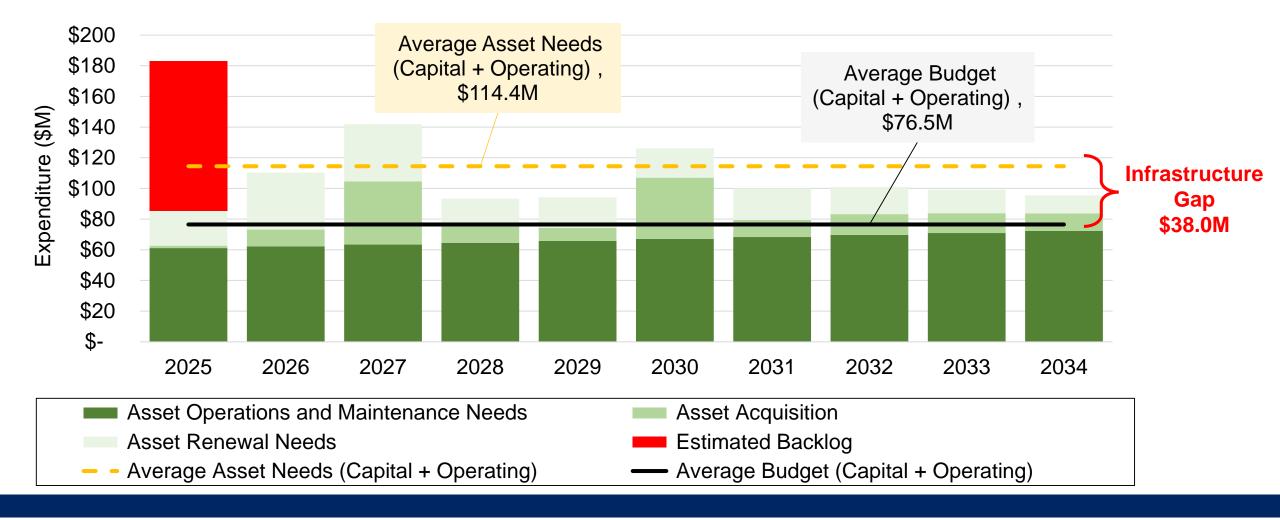
Levels of Service (LOS)

- LOS translate customer and corporate expectations into measurable asset performance targets
- LOS are categorized into 5 different attributes
- The 2025 AMP sets current LOS baselines as the proposed targets for 2025 - 2034
- Focus on Quality and Reliability and technical, condition-based performance measures
