



**BY-LAW NO. 2026-0032**

A By-law to amend the Town's Sign By-law No. 2003-0065 to remove provisions relating to Election Signs

**WHEREAS** by Subsection 11(2) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, as amended, Councils of municipalities may pass By-law respecting Signs and Advertising Devices;

**AND WHEREAS** on April 20, 2026, Council for the Town of Halton Hills approved Report No. ADMIN-2026-009, dated February 20, 2026, in which certain recommendations were made relating to Town of Halton Hills Sign By-law 2003-0065.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF HALTON HILLS ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. For the purposes of this By-law:

**SECTION 6, SIGNS NOT REQUIRING A PERMIT**

Section 6.1.6 will be removed in its entirety

**SECTION 7, SIGNS WITHIN A RESIDENTIAL, INSTITUTIONAL, OR OPEN SPACE ZONE**

Section 7.1.4 will be removed in its entirety.

**SECTION 10, PORTABLE SIGNS ON ROAD ALLOWANCE**

Section 10.1.2 & Section 10.1.3 will be removed in its entirety.
