I am providing this letter to you as part of our notification process for work that Bell Canada will be doing in Glen Williams. This work is estimated to begin in late September or early October, depending on when utility locates become available.

The construction is part of Bell's project to bring advanced communications infrastructure to homes and business throughout the Town of Halton Hills. Our contractor, NX Utilities, will be drilling new conduits and installing Bell's all-fibre network in the Glen Williams area.

During the COVID-19 situation, all construction work is performed under Ontario's essential services regulations and in close cooperation with the Town of Halton Hills, as well as all public health and safety measures.

Please note that this work will not affect your Bell services and all landscaping will be restored to its original condition. We aim to complete restoration within a maximum of 30 days upon completion of the work in your neighborhood. In the event that restoration is complete but later requires more attention (i.e. weather conditions cause sod to fail), we will ensure to follow up and make all needed repairs. Bell and NX Utilities will warranty the sod restoration until the grass roots.

Mayor Bonnette:

On June 16, 2020, our government consulted on Proposed Amendment 1 to **A Place to Grow: Growth Plan for the Greater Golden Horseshoe** (**A Place to Grow**). As part of the COVID-19 economic recovery efforts, the proposed changes included updates to the population and employment forecasts and related policy changes; a change to the Plan horizon year; a change to address Major Transit Station Areas within Provincially Significant Employment Zones (PSEZ); and other policy revisions that support our government's objectives to increase housing supply, create more jobs, attract business investments and better align infrastructure. Our government also consulted on a new Land Needs Assessment methodology concurrently. Both consultation periods closed on July 31, 2020.

As a result of our recent consultation, our government has amended **A Place to Grow** and released a new market-based Land Needs Assessment methodology. The Environmental Registry of Ontario decision notices can be found at:

An office consolidation version of Amendment 1 to **A Place to Grow** can be found here and the new market-based approach to Land Needs Assessment Methodology can be found here.

These changes will help municipalities anticipate and plan for growth, as well as support economic recovery from the COVID-19 outbreak. The amendments work together to provide more flexibility to your municipality as you do your long-term planning to address demographic, employment, market demand, and housing affordability trends in the Greater Golden Horseshoe. As well, following feedback received from Indigenous partners, environmental and agricultural stakeholders, we are no longer moving forward on new mineral aggregate operation policies.

These changes will come into effect today, August 28, 2020. The date by which upper and single-tier municipalities must update their official plans to conform with the policies in **A Place to Grow** will remain July 1, 2022. For lower-tier municipalities, the deadline for conformity with this Plan will continue to be one year after the relevant upper-tier conformity amendment takes effect.

Provincial Matters

The Government of Ontario is making \$8 million available for small business and registered charities struggling to pay their energy bills (natural gas and electricity). The COVID-19 Energy Assistance Program for Small Business provides a one time, on-bill credit to help catch up on energy bills and resume regular payments. To apply for funding, customers should contact their energy provider. For more information, including eligibility requirements and on-bill credit amounts, visit oeb.ca/ceap.

Reg 244/97 - implementing the *Aggregate Resources Act* - has been amended. While these changes do not address concerns raised about below water table extraction and possible impacts on municipal sources of drinking water, other changes are welcomed. These include the requirement to apply for a licence where new below water table extraction is proposed and the ability to object if concerns over a new

Sections of the act pertaining to animal transportation will come into effect on September 2, 2020 (see <u>consultation document</u>). Further consultation is sought on a potential Minister's Regulation at <u>Ontario's Regulatory Registry</u> until October 15, 2020.
