Each of the 21 sills will have the existing paint removed, have caulking or epoxy applied to damaged area to seal the surface; will be primed and then painted.

Although such large brick houses from the 1880s were usually built with stone window sills, the Norval Presbyterian Manse was built with large wooded sills.
